## PARTNERSHIP BUILDING: LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING CENTER

The **FIRST FLOOR** will include rooms for tactical training and fitness, 911 backup/training, crime scene incident and quartermaster's rooms for the WPD and Sheriff's Department.

The **SECOND FLOOR** will primarily house classrooms for the WPD and Sheriff's Department, and the third floor will include classrooms and offices for the WSU Criminal Justice Program, which includes the Regional Community Policing Institute and the Midwest Criminal Justice Institute, 500 students and 12 faculty and staff.
